Your Challenge: Create a poster that shows the Co-op Values or our Ways of Being translated into a different language! You can use French, Spanish, Urdu, or any other language you speak at home (Romanian, Kurdish, Roma, Tigrinya etc)

What to Include on Your Poster:

- ✓ The Co-op Values or Ways of Being written in English.
- ✓ The same word/phrase translated into your chosen language.
- ✓ Creative designs – drawings, flags, symbols, or pictures that represent the values.
- ✓ (Optional) A short explanation in English about why these values are important.

Co-op Values	Ways of Being
Self-help – Encouraging people to help themselves to improve their lives.	Do what matters most – Focus on what will make the biggest difference for students and the community.
Self-responsibility – Encouraging individuals to take responsibility for their actions.	
Democracy – Giving individuals a voice and ensuring fairness.	Be yourself, always – Value individuality and encourage people to be their authentic selves.
Equality – Ensuring everyone is treated fairly and has equal opportunities.	Show you care – Demonstrate kindness, empathy, and support for others.
Equity – Recognizing that different people need different levels of support to succeed.	
Solidarity – Standing together to support one another and the wider community.	
	Succeed together – Work collaboratively and help each other achieve success.

How to Translate the Words:

- ♦ Use a dictionary – If you have one at home, look up each word carefully.
- ♦ Try an online translator – Google Translate or WordReference can help, but check if the translation makes sense!
- ♦ Ask someone who speaks the language – A family member, friend, or even a teacher!
- ♦ Break it down – If a full sentence is tricky, focus on individual words, or create a translation that gets the idea across, even if it isn't word-for-word exact.

Presentation:

- Your poster can be hand-drawn on paper or made digitally.
- Be creative – use colors, pictures, and neat writing!
- If you don't have access to materials, a simple word list with drawings is perfect.
